The Friends and Family Test is a great way of quickly and easily letting us know how we are doing – it is a very brief survey, and the results are refreshed every month.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS

It is important that you tell us if you move, so we can ensure communications re appointments, referrals etc find you in the post. You can update your details in the practice or use the form on our website.

We understand that taking care of your or your family's health can be stressful, and things may not move as quickly as any of us would like, however, venting frustration at our staff cannot and will not be tolerated; please bear with us while we do our best to help you; the practice, may, if need be, apply to have patients removed from our list

SATURDAY OPENING

The practice is open on Saturdays, primarily in response to the demand from patients who are busy during the week. We suggest these appointments be used for routine matters; please note that they must be booked in advance. The practice is open from 09:00 to 17:00.

MEDICAL STUDENTS

Holborn Medical Centre is a teaching practice, and many of you will have had a chance to consult with one of our GP registrars, fully qualified doctors, who, for a period of 1 year, undergo specialist GP training.

We have medical students, on rotation, in the later stages of their medical education, for shorter periods.

You do not have to have a medical student sitting in on your consultation, or even conducting the consultation, however, your help in our training the next generation of GPs is very much appreciated when you do consult with them.

PATIENT PARTICIPATION

We would like very much to review the practice performance, with reference to surveys, and personal experience – once we have the results of the practice survey back, we will be holding a Patient Participation Group meeting and would like to ensure that as many patients as possible are able to attend – please keep an eye out for posters, and announcements via the website.
